

A Brush With Kindness

In order to be eligible for the program you must meet the following requirements:

- Be unable due to age, disability or financial constraints to perform the work on your own
- Be below 60% of the median family income limits as set by HUD for Door County
- Be willing to assist with the project by preparing food for volunteers, helping with the work as able or supporting the effort in other ways to be determined by our Family Selection Committee
- Be a Door County resident for 12 months
- Own the home to be painted

About the program

Habitat for Humanity's *A Brush with Kindness* is a locally-operated program serving low-income homeowners who struggle to maintain the exterior of their homes. The program is a holistic approach to providing affordable housing and assisting communities as well as families.

How we do it

- Groups of volunteers help homeowners with exterior painting chores.
- Habitat selects partner families based on income, need and willingness to partner.
- In addition to volunteers, Habitat uses donated materials and takes no profit for their services.

Why it matters

A Brush with Kindness ensures that families live in safe and well-maintained homes. The program is designed to revitalize the appearance of the neighborhood, encourage connections within the community, and most importantly, help preserve affordable housing stock.
